Have You Seen Us Around Town???



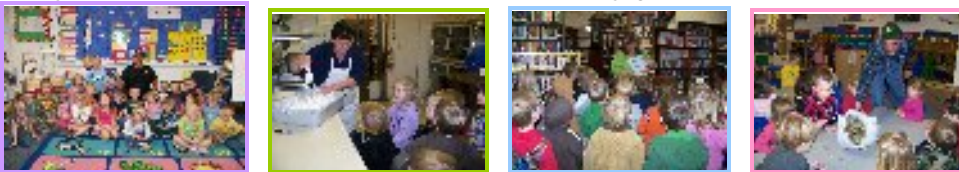
