Important Arrival & Dismissal Information

Teacher's Institute will be held on August 17 and 18. **The first day for students will be August 19.** This is a full day. The La Harpe Elementary and Junior High School first bell will ring at 7:55 a.m. **Classes will begin daily at 8:00 a.m. and dismiss at 3:00 p.m.**

ARRIVAL: Morning bus routes will run on similar schedules to last year with buses arriving at school at approximately 7:30 a.m. (Fountain Green Route, 7:50 a.m.) La Harpe District will continue to provide transportation for Illini West High School (IWHS) students living in the La Harpe District. **High school shuttle buses will leave from La Harpe School at 7:36 a.m.** and arrive at IWHS at approximately 8:05 a.m. **HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MAY PARK ONLY IN THE LOT BEHIND THE OLD BUILDING ON ARCHER STREET.**

All students arriving at school before 7:45 a.m. are to go to the cafeteria. At 7:45 a.m., students will be allowed in the main building. **K-8th grade students may only** be dropped off and picked up at the E Street school entrances. **Pre-K students** may be dropped off and picked up at the north side of the school building in the lot on Archer. Pre-K parents should park and escort their children to the cafeteria before 7:45 a.m. or to the Pre-K room after 7:45 a.m.

NOTE: D STREET WILL BE CLOSED DURING ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL TIMES and will be used for BUSES ONLY.

DISMISSAL: ALL La Harpe students who ride the bus, are picked up, or walk will be released at the 3:00 p.m. bell. The PK town bus and PK-8 country buses will begin their routes as soon as students are loaded. Supervision will not be provided after school as buses will load & leave at the 3:00 p.m. dismissal time.

High School shuttle bus students will be dismissed from IWHS at 3:15 p.m. and will arrive back at La Harpe School at approximately 3:45 p.m. at which time the separate high school routes will begin.

School Improvement Day dismissal time for La Harpe will be 12:30 p.m. Elem/JH buses will leave La Harpe School at 12:30 p.m.. High School buses will follow Illini West's SIP dismissal time.

CLASSROOM LOCATIONS:All K - 8th grade classrooms are located in the main school building on the west side of D Street. Pre-K is located in the former band building located on the east side of D Street. Music and Art classes are located in the Johnson building. The school office is located in the main school building at the southwest corner of the gym, and may be most easily accessed from the southwest entrance off of E Street. The Central Office is on Main Street.

K-5 WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT

Welcome Back to School Night will be held on **Tuesday evening, August 18th, from 4:00 to 6:00 p.m.** We invite parents to bring your K-8 students and their school supplies to their classrooms during this time. Your child's teacher will be available to visit with you and help students put away their supplies. We encourage all K-8 students and their parents to attend.

REGISTRATION DAY - Thursday, August 6th

Registration for all students in Pre-Kindergarten through 8th grades will take place in the school library on Thursday, August 6th, from 8 a.m.- 6 p.m. If you are unable to register on the 6th, you may register at the school office after the 6th until the start of school.

New students should bring a birth certificate or other government documentation of the child's identity and an affidavit explaining the inability to produce a copy of the birth certificate, proof of immunizations, proof of residence in La Harpe district, document of transfer form (issued by previous school district if located in Illinois), and name and address of previous school attended.

ALL students must be registered by a parent or legal guardian. If a parent is not the legal guardian, the school needs a copy of a legal document giving guardianship to the named individual.

Parents will be asked to pay book rent and fees, complete a payment plan, or complete a waiver request form. For a waiver request form to be approved, at least one of the following statements must be true: the student is currently

receiving aid under Article IV of the Illinois Public Aid Code; the student is currently eligible for free or reduced priced breakfast and lunch; the student's family is currently eligible under the guidelines of the family-size income levels prescribed annually by the Secretary of Agriculture; or additional factors such as major illness in the family, unusual expenses such as fire, flood, storm damage, seasonal unemployment, or emergency situations. There will be no sports participation fee this year. For more details, see the fee schedule in this newsletter.

Parents will be asked to fill out General Registration Information, Medication Information, and PK-8 Dismissal Procedures at registration. Be sure to pick up a handbook. Parents of new students will need to sign an Internet Use or Publication Permission form.

Parents are encouraged to fill out the Free and Reduced Lunch Form which is included in this mailing and bring it to registration to determine whether your family qualifies for this benefit. All financial information is kept confidential. Fee Waiver Forms for those parents who qualify and Insurance Forms will be available.

BUS ROUTE CHANGES

Afternoon bus routes have been changed to transport elementary and high school students home separately to coincide with their different daily dismissal times. La Harpe PK-8th grade afternoon routes will run from 3-4pm. High school shuttles will leave at the Illini West dismissal time, return to La Harpe, then begin the afternoon routes.

Morning Routes will follow a schedule similar to last year.

Elementary & Junior High Yearbooks may be picked up at Registration on August 6th.

Student Accident Insurance

All K-8 students will be insured with School Time Student Accident coverage at no cost to the parents. The district-provided coverage is effective for all school activities. If you wish your child to be covered for non school-sponsored activities, you may opt to purchase additional Around-the-Clock or 24-Hour coverage. We are offering optional additional Student Accident Insurance from 2 companies again this year. **Brochures from both companies will be available at registration.**

PRESCHOOL

Preschool Registration

Preschool students will also register on August 6th from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. in the library this year. ALL parents that received a letter about preschool should plan to attend on August 6th. If this is your child's first year, you will need to bring a current physical with immunizations, lead screening results, a birth certificate, your child's social security number, and possibly money for breakfast and lunch for the first week. If this is your child's second year, we will need you to fill out current emergency information. La Harpe's preschool program is based on screening results and each child entering must qualify.

Preschool Screening will be held August 6th

If you have a child that is three or four years old, La Harpe preschool will be holding this second screening for this school year. This screening will provide parents and teachers with information on your child's developmental level. Your child must go through a screening to qualify for La Harpe's preschool program. If your child attended the screening in February, you do not have to bring your child to this screening. The August screening is for families that missed the first one or that have recently moved to La Harpe.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS & IMMUNIZATIONS

A **PHYSICAL EXAM** is required for any student entering **Kindergarten (or entering school for the first time) and 6th grade**. Pre-K or K students who were enrolled in one of the La Harpe District pre-school programs last year do not have to furnish proof of another physical examination. The following immunizations are required for entrance in public school at Pre-K (or Kindergarten) and 6th grade: Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, Measles, Rubella, Mumps, Haemophilus Influenza Type B, Hepatitis B. For students entering Pre-K or Kindergarten, proof of immunity to chickenpox (Varicella) is also required. If the health care provider cannot vaccinate the child due to the shortage of a vaccine, a written statement from the health care provider must be provided for school records. Also children entering Pre-K, Kindergarten, or entering school for the first time, shall be screened for lead poisoning.

A current **SPORTS PHYSICAL** is required for **any student who plans to participate in athletics**.

EYE EXAM: All students entering **Kindergarten (or for the first time enrolled in Illinois)** must have an eye examination. Vision screening is not a substitute for this eye exam. This eye exam may be completed up to one year prior to the beginning of school. Proof of eye exam is due by October 15 of the school year.

DENTAL EXAM: Children entering **Kindergarten, 2nd and 6th grades** are re-

quired to have an oral health exam. Proof of examination by a licensed dentist must be presented before May 15th of the school year.

All forms may be obtained at the Central Office at 404 West Main Street in LaHarpe.

Please bring completed forms with you on Registration Day, August 6th. An appointment card will be accepted. State law requires local districts to refuse admittance to those students who do not comply. All students must meet the minimum immunization requirements of the State of Illinois by October 15th or be excluded from school until they are met.

Physical Examinations may be obtained at the Hancock County Health Dept. open Monday through Friday. Parents must call ahead for an appointment at (217) 357-2171. The Health Dept. performs sports physicals for \$10 and school physicals for \$25. There is a \$10 fee for most immunizations. Parents must provide the clinic with their child's record of previous immunizations.

The Hancock County Health Dept. also offers a Dental Clinic which serves Medicaid and non-insured residents at a lower fee. Call the Health Dept. for an appointment or for more information at (217)357-6984. Dental Clinic hours are Monday through Thursday from 8a.m. until 5 p.m.

ATHLETIC TRAINING SERVICES

McDonough District Hospital will again provide athletic training services to area junior high students, coaches and teachers during the 2009-10 school year.

Bruce Schellhammer, Physical Therapist and Athletic Trainer, will be available on a weekly basis to all participating schools.

Bruce joined the MDH Rehabilitation Services staff in 2007. He has more than 25 years of experience in treating sports injuries. He is a certified strength and conditioning specialist and is a credentialed sports specialist physical therapist.

Bruce can assist in the development of a strength and conditioning program to fit your needs, as well as provide sports injury assessments, follow-up visits, and consultation for the treatment of sports injuries. Bruce can also make referrals for services through the MDH Sports Medicine and Rehabilitation Clinic, located at 1214 N. Lafayette St. in Macomb.

Students who are interested in utilizing this service should talk with their coach or athletic director to set up an appointment.

BREAKFAST: Students may eat breakfast in the school cafeteria beginning at 7:30 a.m. The menu includes breakfast pizza, cold cereal (choice of 3), rolls or donuts, toast, juice, and milk. All students will be served a complete breakfast.

Annual Asbestos Management Plan Notice

La Harpe Community School District #347 maintains an asbestos management plan. It has been determined by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Federal Environmental Protection Agency that asbestos is a potential health hazard, and precautions should be taken to avoid disturbing any asbestos containing materials.

As required, our buildings were initially inspected for asbestos. The initial inspection was conducted on November 11, 1988. The AHERA law requires that a visual surveillance of asbestos containing areas be completed every six months, and a re-inspection conducted every three years. Any evidence of disturbance or change in condition will be documented in the Management Plan as required.

The Inspection/Management Plan is available for public review in the Central Office. Should you wish to review the plans, please call to make an appointment between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

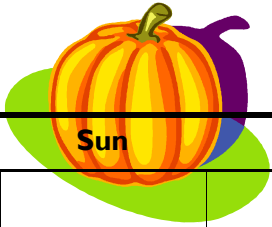
