I am sure we are all glad to see sports finally return to Illinois and I am excited our kids will get the opportunity to play in games. At LaHarpe we have created opportunities for a limited number of fans to attend events.

- Each player has only two tickets for their family. I know some of you may have younger children and you would like to bring them with you. I understand. However, we are limited by the state how many fans can attend. I am sorry. I wish we could pack the gym!
- You will be required to wear your mask from the time you enter the building until the time you leave.
- Once you enter the building you will check in with the ticket taker and provide your name, your phone number, and will have your temperature taken. This is for contact tracing if the need would ever arise.
- Once signing in you will be shown your assigned area in the gym. This is where you will sit for all home games. The areas are spaced out at 6 feet as required by the state. You have been given about 3 or 4 feet in your area. At this time you will sit on the South side of the gym on the very top bleacher. I have placed your daughters(volleyball is the only sport at this time with games approaching) name tag on the bleachers where you should sit. You need to remain there for the entire time you are in the gym unless you need to use the restroom.
- NO LaHarpe/Dallas City fans will be allowed to attend AWAY games. There will be no away fans at our home games.
- There will be no concession stand available at our games. Please make sure your daughter/son has plenty to drink during the game.
- I am asking that your daughter/son arrive at the game ready to play with their

uniform on. Your daughter/son may change their shoes at the bench. There will be no locker rooms available for your daughter/son to use.

- WE NEED TO DO THIS RIGHT! I ask you wear your mask correctly, remain in your designated seating area, and use appropriate fan behavior. I have had a difficult time finding officials during this Covid epidemic and I am thankful for the ones willing to continue to ref for our children.

As an athlete your daughter/son loves to see their parents/family in the stands. Some schools are not allowing fans at all – home or away! Some of you may agree or disagree with our approach. Trust me, we only have the best interest of all involved. I am grateful for our coaches, administration, and maintenance that have assisted making these athletic seasons a reality.
