## LA HARPE CSD 347 SAFE RETURN PLAN FOR 2022-2023 SCHOOL YEAR

- 1. In accordance with the most recent guidelines of the CDC, IDPH, and ISBE, layered mitigations will still be in place, such as option of physical distancing, option of masking, proper handwashing and respiratory etiquette, improvement of ventilation, and continued sanitizing and cleaning.
- 2. Educational opportunities for the 2022-2023 school year will be in-person, unless an individual voluntarily quarantines. Then, remote/off-campus learning is available to those during the time of quarantine. Appropriate accommodations are available for children with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies.
- 3. Social, emotional, and mental health of students and staff will be continually monitored and addressed.
- 4. Masks are optional, and no one will be discriminated against while wearing or not wearing a mask.
- 5. At any time, local conditions change, mitigations may be removed or added, as deemed necessary by the Southeastern School Board working collaboratively with the Hancock County Health Department.

The plan was developed through consultation with students, parents, school staff and health department officials.
